

# The Great Work (Th.Berry)

#### The Great Work before us:



The task of moving modern industrial civilization from its present devastating influence on the Earth to a more benign mode of presence.

Humans need a new understanding of their role and place in the universe and the whole community of life.

#### How?

All human institutions, professions, programs and activities must now be judged primarily by the extend to which they inhibit, ignore or foster a mutually enhancing human-Earth relationship.

# The Three Building Blocks in working for the transition of our time

#### 1. The Sacred Story of the Universe

- Awakens in us a deep wonder about how everything came into existence of everything and gives us an new understanding of our place in the universe.
- The Story connects us with people beyond clan, family and tribe and provides a unifying vision for action.
- The story gives words to the change we experience now.

#### 2. Bioregionalism

- 1. A bioregion is a naturally occurring self-supporting geobiological unit. We know the place where we live; our local community of life, our bio-home.
- 2. We are aware of our place in the community of life and our life and mission are rooted in and coming from this strong bondedness. We have entered into the community of life.
- 3. This gives us a new vision for the ordering of society: we are one with all that is alive around us: the human and more- than -human community.

 Bioregionalism is the "doing" dimension of the Ecozoic Society. It is the way in which we put an ecological vision into practice and make it happen.

 Examples of Bioregionalism are: Permaculture movement, Eco-villages, Transition Towns and many other movements throughout the world.

 All we do flows from discernment: does this action inhibit, ignore foster a mutually enhancing human-Earth relationship?

#### 3. Ecological Spirituality

 Ecological spirituality is the "being" dimension of the Ecozoic Society.

 Grounded in the sense that, from the beginning, the universe had a psychic /spiritual dimension and this dimension is manifest in every element of the universe and the universe as a whole.

#### The call and work for transition of our time

 Now the time has come that people live again with and from a deep respect for the Earth.

 Now we will take up the task of changing the relationship of humans with the Earth: no longer exploitation and devastation, but harmony between humans and the rest of the Earth – community.

What will make human life really blossom in the midst of the Earth community?


Our future as humanity is deeply intertwined with the future of the whole community of life.
